New Features in Policy Commander 3.0

1. All components of Policy Commander (server, console, client, editors for policies and packages) now support the latest Windows operating systems (Windows 7 and Server 2008 R2) on 32 and 64 bit platforms.
2. It is now possible to fine-tune which roles can assign policies to mission-critical groups of computers.
3. NBTProxy web service enables any managed computer with an internet connection to communicate securely with the Policy Commander server, whether or not it is on the corporate network.
4. The External Tools feature makes it possible to add right-click menu commands to managed computers to launch external applications on the computer.
5. WMI classes and properties can now be used for policy compliance steps and applicability steps, in addition to being used for configuration groups.
6. It is now possible to import SmartUpdate configuration group rulesets from New Boundary Technologies from within the Policy Commander Console. Simply right-click on the *Configuration Groups* heading in the left-hand pane and choose *Import Groups*.
7. It is now possible to specify alternate account credentials when doing a direct install of the Policy Commander client. This enables cross-domain direct installs, as well as direct installs to computers in workgroups.
8. It is now possible to receive email alerts when computers join or leave configuration groups.
9. Numerous other infrastructure upgrades, performance enhancements and fixes that were made to shared components of New Boundary Technologies' IT product line are now included in Policy Commander 3.0.
